Application fee is \$95 and program deposit is \$500. Deposit goes towards program cost, which varies depending on the location selected (housing is included in this cost). Our costs for summer internships are posted on each program page at <https://www.aifsabroad.com/> and range from \$6,990 (San Jose) to \$9,490 (London). Locations like the UK and Australia have additional visa costs. Students earning academic credit can typically use scholarships and financial aid towards their program.
